Current suggested donations are: small organisations £60 (£23 for general funds & £37 for n:vision rent) and £85 for larger (£33 g.f. & £52 n:vision)- these are now again due, please!

General Fund. £316.25 has been paid, from the £500 set aside from the Christmas Tree event money, to Friends of St Peters for the improvement to their sound system. (£183.75 in hand) A £100 donation has been made to ‘Christian Vision for Men’ in relation to the commencement of ‘Men in Christ – Sudbury’.
